REQUIREMENTS AND PROVISIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP IN LAS CRUCES PALLIATIVE CARE COALITION (LCPCCC)

Individual = one single individual associated with an organization

Organization = hospital, hospice, home health or home care agency, or other health related agency or firm, or any individual willing to pay an organizational proportionate share of costs incurred by the coalition approved by a majority vote at a regular monthly meeting of LCPCCC

1. Individuals must attend at least 50% of monthly meetings over a one year period.
2. Membership is cancelled if an individual fails to attend three consecutive monthly meetings without an excuse. Excused absences may be obtained from the chairperson when notification of a planned absence is given before the meeting . Post- meeting excuses are unacceptable.
3. Cancellation of membership occurs on the date of the 3rd consecutive monthly meeting missed without an excuse.
4. Member acknowledges roll is taken monthly.
5. A quorum of organizations is required for any voting to take place. However all individuals are encouraged to be involved in all discussions.
6. Voting is according to one vote per organization. Only organizations are allowed to vote.
7. Each organization accepts responsibility for proportionate payment of any costs incurred by LCPCCC when approved at a regularly scheduled monthly meeting.
8. Guests may be invited by individuals for any regularly scheduled monthly meeting.
9. New organizations may be accepted into membership in LCPCCC if approved by the existing membership at a regularly scheduled monthly meeting.

Any future additional organizations wishing to join Las Cruces Palliative Care Coalition will be required to pay the \$250-\$300 fee into the CFSNM fund, should LCPCCC become a CFSNM affiliate
